School Uniform and Dress Code

Compulsory School Uniform for all Year 0-6 students, The dress code has been designed to give students a wide choice of options whilst maintaining a school identity.

- Compulsory School Uniform Sun Hat for Yr 0-6 students in terms 1 and 4
- Shoes or sandals are to be plain black
- Socks are to be plain black
- Girls winter tights to be black
- Polypropylene or thermals (winter months) worn under the school uniform must be black

Notes:

- Students must wear regulation school uniform, non uniform items similar in colour and style are not acceptable.
- When a student comes to school with incorrect uniform and without a notice of explanation, parents are contacted and asked to collect their child, and take them home to dress them correctly and then return them to school. However the school does have items that students can borrow and will be instructed to wear for the day.
- Any non uniform clothing items will be confiscated and must be collected by the student at the end of each day or by parents.
- The school accepts no responsibility for any non uniform clothing items.
- All school uniform items should be clearly named.
- The only jewellery items to be worn are medic alert ID, small stud earrings, a wrist watch or items of religious or cultural significance.

Community of Learning

The Rotorua Central Community of Learning (CoL) comprises six schools: Glenholme School; Malfroy School; Rotorua Boys' High School; Rotorua Girls' High School; Rotorua Intermediate; and Rotorua Seventh Day Adventist School.

The six schools are geographically situated within three kilometres of each other and provide a natural education pathway for students living within the central city suburbs. The schools are similar in many aspects including the high percentage of Maori students. The principals, senior leadership and teaching staff have already worked collaboratively as an e-learning network and have undertaken leadership development together. A culture of professional sharing and respect exists among these schools already and with the introduction of the Rotorua Central CoL the schools will continue to developed and enhance these relationships whilst undertaking achievement challenges to raise student achievement across all six schools. Nancy Macfarlane Principal of Glenholme School is the lead principal for the Rotorua Central CoL. This responsibility is fully supported by the Glenholme School Board of Trustees and the staff. The CoL responsibilities have and will continue to require Mrs Macfarlane's time and professional expertise. However Glenholme School parents and whanau can be reassured that the management staff and teaching staff will uphold the expectations to ensure our tamariki are provided with the stimulation, challenge and support needed to become successful learners.

Ranolf Street School Entrance

Reminder that the Ranolf Street Entrance is not a drop off and or pick up zone. It is imperative that the school environment ensures all students are safe at all times. After months of redesigning and negotiations, developments will be underway shortly for the electronic gate system to be operational again. Pedestrian access will be available, based on the previous system, any one arriving via the Ranolf Street entrance in a car will need to utilise an intercom system.

Lost Property

We have an ongoing problem with our lost property. We regularly have large piles of unnamed and unrecognised clothing. Currently lost property is kept alongside the caretakers shed in the front of the school. Lost clothing is on show for the children to look at, and if not claimed within 4 weeks is collected, washed and is likely to be on sold in the second hand uniform sales. Any named property is given back to the owner. Students are responsible for their clothing, please check that children bring items home each day. Please ensure that the school uniform is clearly named.

Swimming Pool

We have a lovely pool. It is heated and well maintained, with good quality changing sheds and toilets. We aim to try to teach all children water confidence, water safety and basic swimming as a part of the compulsory Health and Physical Education Curriculum. Children are expected to swim as part of their learning programme. Please help us by making sure that your child has **named** togs and towel during their swimming weeks. If your child is too sick to swim then a note should be provided to the teacher. We do not allow children with open sores to swim for the welfare of all.

Bikes, Scooters, Roller Blades and Skateboards

These items are no longer appropriate for use in the school grounds. Biking to and from school is not effected, however these devices in and around school, before or after will no longer be tolerated. For astro-turf care and protection such devices are not to be used at anytime. Students that have attended GASP or played at school will no longer be able to do so. Thank you for your support and understanding.

Dental Therapist and Service

The Rotorua District Health Board has a Mobile Clinic Service that will visit Glenholme School. 2017 the Mobile Clinic is expected to complete our visit in Term Two, returning in 2018. The Mobile Clinic when on site will be situated behind A1 Classroom. Any dental emergencies parents will need to contact Rotorua District Health regarding the nearest operating Dental Service in Rotorua to get treatment. Do not contact the school, unfortunately we will not be able to help direct you to treatment as it is the Ministry of Health and Rotorua District Health Board that manage the dental service and not the school or Ministry of Education.
