## **REMINDERS**

### **Communication to Students**

I would like to remind parents to make after school arrangements with your child before they come to school. Our office staff are happy to help in an emergency yet we are receiving messages to forward to children that do not fall into this category. We are concerned with the volume of messages we are receiving and can't always guarantee that the messages will be passed on during the day. Classes are often spread over the school site and if they are in class we aim to minimise the disruption to student learning.

### **Collecting students**

Parents are asked to call in at the office if they are collecting children during the day. This is for the safety of our students when they are in our care at school. All children need to be collected at 3pm or be in GASP Care. There is no supervision of the playgrounds after 3pm.

### **School Donations 2017**

Glenholme School 2017 donation will remain at \$20.00 a term per student or \$70.00 for the year if paid in full during Term One. If you have 2 or more children and pay in the first term you will only need to pay \$60 per child for the year.

School donations are greatly appreciated. Donations from parents and whanau are wisely allocated toward student special programmes. Please consider supporting the school and making provisions for our students that they may miss out on if donations are not made. Parents are welcome to set up automatic payments to cover School donations for the year or use the EFTPOS facilities.

### **Free Health Care for Glenholme School Students**

- There is a free nurse available for Glenholme School children who have sore throats or skin infections like school sores, nits and scabies.
- The nurse will be available from 10.15—11am on Wednesdays at Glenholme School. **It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided.**
- This is a new nurse service to prevent rheumatic fever in our school. Rheumatic Fever damages children's hearts.
- Children and young people aged between 4 and 19 with sore throats or skin infections can also use the free clinic - to see the nurse, please go to Western Heights Health Centre in the afternoon between 3 and 6 pm Monday to Thursday or 3 and 5 pm Friday, or call 3470565, txt 0224847628 (022 4throat).
- It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided. Children seen by the nurse stay registered with their usual GP.
- Please get sore throats treated and protect children's hearts.

Simply enter the event code: and press “Go”.

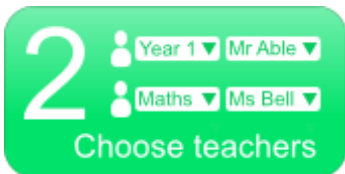

We have allowed 15 minutes for each Academic Achievement Discussions. Please do not be offended when a bell goes to indicate to you and the teacher that your appointment has



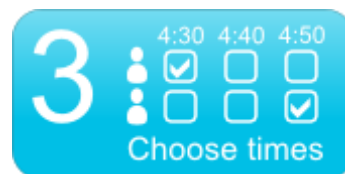
First enter your name, your student's name, and your email address.
