#### **Head Lice**

Headlice is a common yet unfortunate ailment for children; however left untreated it can cause huge concerns for the child, parents, class and the school.

Glenholme School would appreciate if all parents/caregivers would check your child's hair and if necessary take appropriate steps to treat any headlice.

If your child has headlice please do not send them back to school until they have been treated. Untreated children may be referred to the Public Health Nurse to avoid continual re-infestation of class members.

Please report any new cases to your child's teacher, as we will endeavor to notify parents.

Please be vigilant and remember we need parents to be pro-active for at least two weeks to break the headlice life cycle.

#### Winter Sports Teams

- In 2017 all students playing winter sports (Miniball, Netball and Hockey) will have sports fees of \$25.00.
- The \$25.00 includes the sports association fee and the school representative uniform.
- The school will subsidize the remaining amount for all sports teams.
- For some students this is a subsidy of \$5.00 and for others \$50.00.
- The school would like to make all sports obtainable to our students and therefore has committed to paying the rest of the team costs.

Parents please check that your child's name is visible on their school uniform. We have noted that recent school uniform items that have been in the lost property have been named but now the name is unreadable. Over a period or time the ink has slowly washed off and is now impossible to decipher.

### Free Health Care for Glenholme School Students


- There is a free nurse available for Glenholme School children who have sore throats or skin infections like school sores, nits and scabies.
- The nurse will be available from 10.15 am—11am on Wednesdays at Glenholme School. It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided.
- There is a new nurse service to prevent rheumatic fever in our school.
   Rheumatic Fever damages children's hearts.
- Children and young people aged between 4 and 19 with sore throats or skin infections can also use the free clinic to see the nurse, please go to Western Heights Health Centre in the afternoon between 3 and 6 pm Monday to Thursday or 3pm to 5 pm Friday, or call 3470565, txt 0224847628 (022 4throat).
- It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided. Children seen by the nurse stay registered with their usual GP.
- Please get sore throats treated and protect children's hearts.
