- The terrain is undulating with small hill features, horse hurdle to climb over, mud and sheep droppings.

**Times and Order of Runners:**

- Times and order of runners: (estimated times only) don't be disappointed, arrive early to ensure you see all the action.
- Students in Whakapoungakau (A1, A2, A3 & A5) and Tihi-o-tonga (B1, B2, B3 & B5) will be running in their age levels and not year levels
- Students in Pukeroa (B6, C6 & C7) and Pukehangī (A6, B4, C8 & C9) will be running in year levels
- The age for students is the first day of term 2 – **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017**. So for example if you have a 9 year old girl who turns 10 on 10<sup>th</sup> May she will still run in the 9 year old girls
- Only the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place getters in the age categories (7, 8, 9, 10 & 11 year olds) will represent Glenholme School at the Inter-School Cross Country on 27th June

## **Ngati Whakaue Education Endowment Trust**

The Ngati Whakaue Education Endowment Trust Board is a statutory Board with Charitable Trust status. The Endowment was established in 1880 by the people of Ngati Whakaue education in Rotorua. In October 1995, the Endowment was amended to give Ngati Whakaue control and to include the 'general purposes of education'. The purpose of the Board is to apply the net revenue (after administration charges) for the general purpose of education.

Glenholme School has, and continues to be will supported by the Ngati Whakaue Education Endowment Trust Board. They, along with the Glenholme School Board of Trustees help fund a number of learning intervention programmes at school - HPP/PPP reading programme, Literacy Pro reading programme, the Toe-by-Toe reading programme and the Talk to Learn oral language programme. Glenholme School is extremely grateful for their continued support to help our tamariki become successful 21st learning century learners.
