## STUDENT HEALTH AND WELL BEING

Currently the school has a lengthy list of illness's that are rampant throughout the school. Many of which are highly contagious.

- School sores
- Head lice
- Stomach Bugs and Vomiting
- Colds and Flu

We would like to encourage parents and whanau to see that your child/ren are seen by a medical professional immediately and treated before retuning to school. If your child/ren and whanau are heavily impacted by illness this winter please ensure that they are medicated (if necessary) and well before returning to school, as this will avoid spreading the illness to peers and staff. Please ensure that you request a medical certificate for the school and present it to the teacher when they return. The Ministry of Education requires medical certificates for more than 3 days absent from school regarding illness.

## Free Health Care for Glenholme School Students

- There is a free nurse available for Glenholme School children who have sore throats or skin infections like school sores, nits and scabies.
- The nurse will be available from 11am to 12.30 Wednesdays at Glenholme School. It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided.
- There is a new nurse service to prevent rheumatic fever in our school. Rheumatic Fever damages children's hearts.
- Children and young people aged between 4 and 19 with sore throats or skin infections can also use the free clinic to see the nurse, please go to Western Heights Health Centre in the afternoon between 3 and 6 pm Monday to Thursday or 3 and 5 pm Friday, or call 3470565, txt 0224847628 (022 4throat).
- It is free to see the nurse and medicine will be provided. Children seen by the nurse stay registered with their usual GP.
- Please get sore throats treated and protect children's hearts.

## **Medication At School**

Students needing to have medication administered at school are required to sign a Prescribed Medication Procedure form at the school office before any medication can be given to students. It is preferable if students need to have medication given 3 times a day, to be given by the parent/caregivers morning, afterschool and night time. But if needed to be taken at school, it is also helpful if caregivers have the medicated dose supplied in a syringe to be given to the office staff. This eliminates any human errors/or wrong doses given to the students.

## Naming School Uniform

Parents please check that your child's name is visible on their school uniform. We have noted that recent school uniform items that have been in the lost property have either not been named at all or the name is now unreadable. Over a period or time the ink has slowly washed off and is now impossible to decipher.
