Glenholme School Ranolf Street Gates

It is imperative that the school environment ensures all students are safe at all times (including eBabies). Pedestrian access is available, via the Ranolf Street. Reminder that the car park is for staff use only. Parents must drop off students outside of the school grounds and not using the car park. **The concreted area directly in front of the school, on and near the entrance footpath and in the school driveway is prohibited.** Registration numbers of cars parked illegally will be recorded and fines will apply. Occasionally you may need to enter the gates i.e. to collect sick children, therefore you may need to utilise the intercom system.

Headlice

Headlice is common in schools. Parents are encouraged to regularly check your child/rens hair. If treatment is required, please ensure it is completed before returning your child/ren to school to avoid further infestations in the class.

Mobile Dental Clinic

Mobile Dental Clinic is on site. Situated behind A Block, directly behind A1 and A2. Glenholme School students will be treated over term three. Parents and whanau with concerns for their tamariki, please pop in and see the dental therapist in the mobile clinic.
