Developments due to Storm Water

On Monday Glenholme School experienced a freak incident with the council storm water drains blocking and leaking sewage by the school hall. The swift reaction by Matua Erik and Mike from Plumberman saved the school from what could have potentially lead to school closure.

However due to their actions the risk was minimised and contained to the hall area and a small area of the field, only. No classrooms or learning areas were impacted.

On Tuesday morning the Ministry of Education and the Lakes District Council moved quickly to provide support and guidance regarding providing a safe and healthy environment for our tamariki. The clean up has been initiated and the areas of concern have been clear of any possible contamination. These areas however will remain out of bounds until the final assessment has been completed that they are safe for tamariki and staff to utilise again. It is expected that this could be up to 7 days.

The School and Board of Trustees would like to assure parents and whanau that the health and well-being of our tamariki is paramount. Our tamariki were and are not in harms way. Therefore the learning can continue to be the focus for our students.

School assembly will not be taking place in the hall on Friday. Principal Awards will be presented in the staffroom at 10am. Parents and whanau welcome. It will also be live on our FaceBook page.
