- Followed by B3 in Term Two.



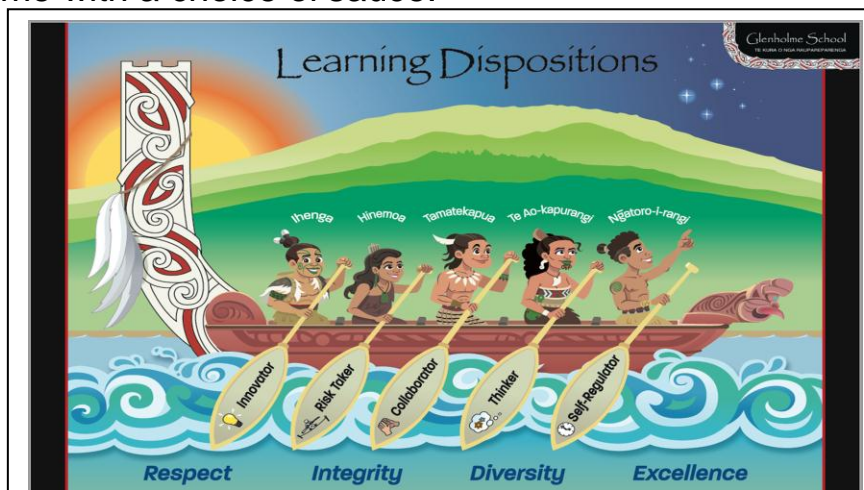
## **Pita Pit School Lunch Programme**

Glenholme School students can now enjoy a healthy, nutritious and delicious meal at school. Pita Pit Rotorua has partnered up with Lunchonline to provide a service that will deliver great food on time to our tamariki.

Parents and Caregivers will find the ordering platform easy to use, and can make an order right up until 9am of the day they want lunch for their child/ren.

### **How does Lunchonline (LOL) work?**

- Parents register and open an account on [www.lunchonline.co.nz](http://www.lunchonline.co.nz)
- Each account can have one or more children.
- When a student is set up on the account, they are attached to a school.
- An order is placed for a student selecting Pita Pit in the Food provider's menu.
- There is a minimum amount of \$10.00 initial credit required, which can be credited to the account via credit card or internet banking.
- When the credit is used, the account can be topped up as required.
- At anytime the account can be closed and the credit balance refunded (less a small administration fee which is waived at the end of the school year).
- Orders can be placed many days in advance.
- Pita Pit has a 9am cut-off time for orders.
- Orders can be cancelled up until the cut-off time so if an order has been made in advance and the child is sick on that day, it is a very easy matter to cancel the order.
- The account will be credited with the value of the cancelled order.
