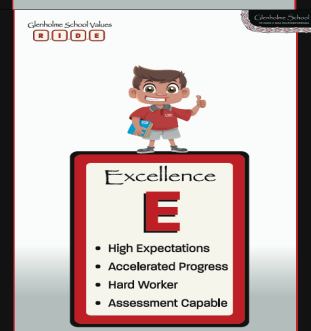
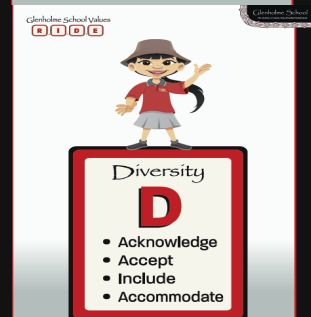

## **SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY—29th May**

School Cross Country champs to be held at the Rotorua Tree Trust Mokoia Drive (behind Te Ohomai Institute of Technology) on Tuesday 29th May (postponement day, Thursday 31st May) from 10am—12.30pm.

- Please support our tamariki by helping out on the day or coming to watch.
- Students need suitable clothing and footwear.
- They can wear mufti sports gear at the event. Changing at school before they head to the event and changing back into school uniform when they return to school.
- Times and order of runners: (estimated times only) don't be disappointed, arrive early to ensure you see all the action.
- Students in Whakapoungakau (A1, A2, A3, A4 & A5) and Tihi-o-tonga (B1, B2, B3, B4 & B5) will be running in their age levels and not year levels.
- Students in Pukeroa (A6, B6, C6 & C7) and Pukehangi (A7, C8 & C9) will be running in year levels.
- The age for students is at the first day of Term 2 – **Monday 30th April 2018**. So for example if you have a 9 year old girl who turns 10 on the 1st May, she will still run in the 9 year old girls
- Only the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place getters in the age categories (8, 9, 10 & 11 year olds) will represent Glenholme School at the Inter-School Cross Country on the 12th June.

### **School Donations**
