Please report any new cases to your child's teacher, as we will endeavor to notify parents.

Please be vigilant and remember we need parents to be pro-active for at least two weeks to break the head lice life cycle.

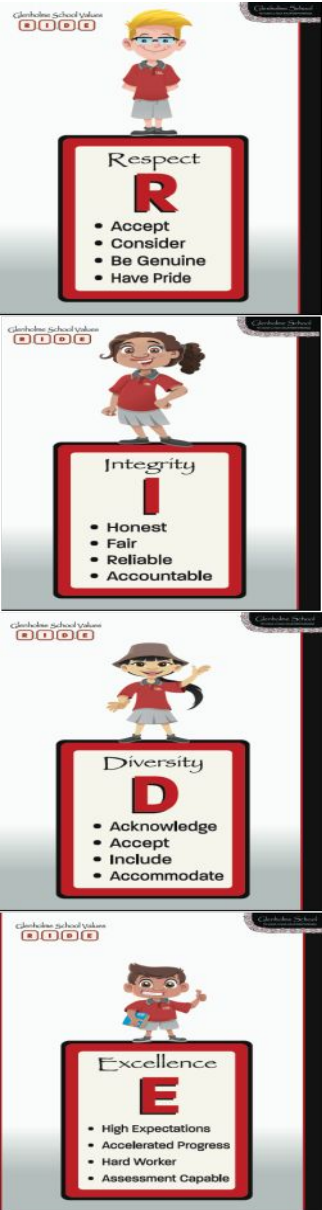

- We have some amazing prizes up for grabs. Many thanks to the organisations who have so far generously donated prizes.

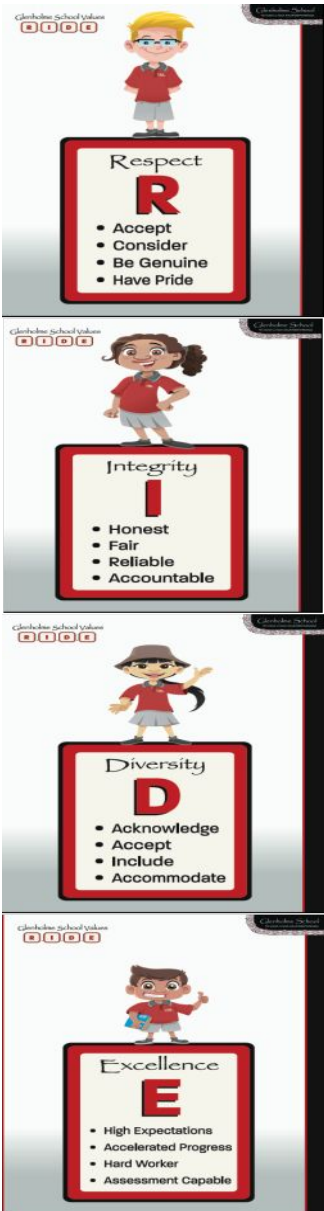
Glenholme After School Programme Change of Hours During the Production
