### PPP (Pause, Prompt, Praise) Tutors Needed

The PPP - Pause, Prompt, Praise Reading Intervention Programme for senior students has been going for 17 years at Glenholme School. The programme was introduced to the school by Colleen Pinfold an ex Glenholme School teacher. For the continual success of this programme we rely on volunteers from our community. We have been very fortunate to have had tutors who have volunteered their time since the programme started. This year we require more tutors so we can start the programme in a couple of weeks time. What this would involve is;

- being available 3 mornings a week for approximately one and a half hours each morning
- working with up to 3 children individually
- working in a provided space at school with the other tutors
