If you have any change of address or new phone numbers please let the office know as soon as possible. These are required to be kept up to date due to any urgent situation or sickness that may develop.

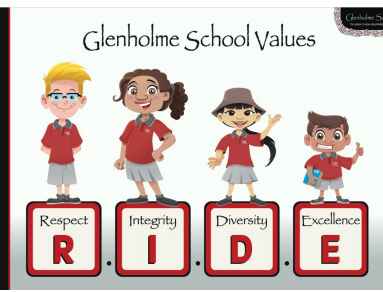

Healthy Lunches in School Programme Rotorua Intermediate. 2020 & 2021.

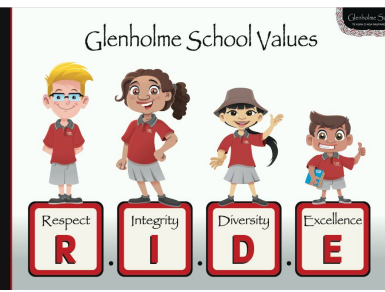

This opportunity will no doubt have a positive impact on student's wellbeing and learning,

All lunches will be prepared on site, and delivered to classrooms during the latter part of our lunch break. Students will be seated to eat, and once finished, be able to continue with their learning programme. All recyclable materials and food waste will be collected and disposed of appropriately by the contracted Libelle providers.
