This will mean free healthy and nutritious lunches being provided to all of our students, each day, five days a week. This opportunity will no doubt have a positive impact on student's wellbeing and learning,

All lunches will be prepared on site, and delivered to classrooms during the latter part of our lunch break. Students will be seated to eat, and once finished, be able to continue with their learning programme. All recyclable materials and food waste will be collected and disposed of appropriately by the contracted Libelle providers.
