#### **Head Lice Information**

Unfortunately head lice has been detected in a number of classrooms.

Head lice is a common yet unfortunate ailment for children; however left untreated it can cause huge concerns for the child, parents, class and the school.

Glenholme School would appreciate if all parents/caregivers would check your child's hair and if necessary take appropriate steps to treat any head lice.

If your child has head lice please do not send them back to school until they have been treated.

Untreated children may be referred to the Public Health Nurse to avoid continual re-infestation of class members.

Please report any new cases to the school office, as we will endeavour to notify parents.

Very effective treatments are readily available from chemists however a combing method is attached as an alternative to the often costly products available.

Please be vigilant and remember we need parents to be proactive for at least two weeks to break the head lice life cycle.


