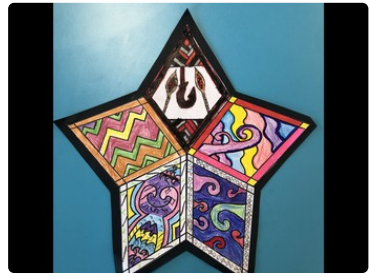
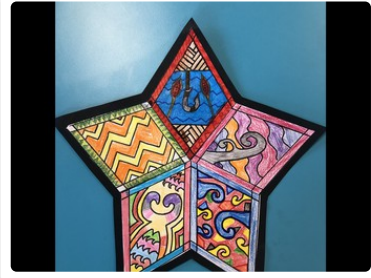
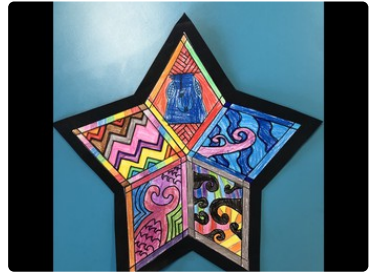
Thank you also to those families and staff members who have donated items to be sent to Fiji. This is very generous and most appreciated.
